TO ALL ARCHERS USING OUR RANGE

When you step onto our range, the following rules **MUST** be adhered to:

1. Keep all bows and crossbows pointed in a safe direction – down range and at a target.
2. Bows must be drawn straight back, and not pointed upward.
3. Crossbows are not permitted for use on 3D targets.
4. Only closed toed shoes are permitted on the range, for your safety.
5. Please stay within your assigned lane(s).
6. Wait until the line is clear before retrieving your arrows.
7. Do not nock arrows until all shooters are back from the target area.
8. Broadheads may not be used on the range.
9. Only drinks with lids are allowed on the range, and must be kept closed when you are not drinking.
10. Remain quiet while other archers are shooting.
11. Tobacco products are discouraged on the range and within the pro shop.
12. No dryfire.
13. No running.
14. No food on the range – this includes gum.
15. No alcohol.
16. No smoking or vaping – Ohio law.
17. No vulgar language.
18. Each shooter must sign the Olde English archery range waiver prior to shooting.

Those choosing to violate these range rules may be asked to leave. Damage caused by violation of these rules will be the responsibility of the shooter.
